

Getting Your Course Credits Back at PSU

If you are not on an official PSU program, the process is more complex and you need to work with the undergraduate admissions office about transfer credit. Here are the procedures you need to follow -- [transferring credits](#).

If you are at an official PSU Program things are a bit easier. The first step is to check the International Programs website -- [accreditation information](#) - for your program and check to see if any of your courses have already been accredited in the past. These will transfer automatically.

If the courses are not already on the books, then you need to work with international programs to have them accredited. You need to fill out forms and attach a detailed syllabus. This needs to be handed in to international programs. This website above also has links to the forms and instructions.

If you want to have some sense of how courses will transfer in advance, please send them to [Angela Hill](#) at the department and we will make a preliminary assessment about what course it will count as. Note that International Programs, not Political Science, determines the number of credits that you will get, and that will have to wait for the official accreditation process.
